and appeared before me Capt. John Masters Comd. of y^e
Kingston Schoon who being also duly sworn did
declare that he was very well acquainted with the
handwriting of M^r Jasper Ashworth and doe believe
the within letter to be written and subscribed by
him and further saith not.
