this behalf I very much confide) full power by the Tenour of
these presents to Administer the Goods, Rights and Credits of the
said Deceased, which to him in his lifetime and at the time of
his decease, did belong and do now, collect, levy, recover and
receive the same, and to pay the debts in which the deceased
stood Obliged, so far forth as the said Goods, Rights and Credits
will Extend according to their Rate and order of Law-
being first Sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God
to make, a True and perfect Inventory thereof & to Exhibit
the same into the Secretary's Office at Charles City as or Before
the Sixteenth day of November next Insuing and to Render a
