Majestys Justices assigned for Berkeley County made Oath
that on the day and year within expressed they were
Present and did see the within named Peter Bocat sign
Seal & deliver the within mentioned deed to the use
therein mentioned & one of the ^{within named} negroes also
delivered one part of the rent and these deponents did sign
their names as witnesses thereof to the within deed.

To all to whom these Presents shall come greeting.
 Know y^e that on the Ninth day of May in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and twenty two
 at Charles Town in the Province aforesaid. Before me in
 Council the Last Will and Testament of Anne Fairchild
 Late of Berkeley County in the said Province deceased
 the Copy whereof as to these presents annexed was proved
 approved and allowed of, the said deceased having whilst
 she lived and at the time of her death divers goods,
 Rights and Credits within the province aforesaid; by
 means whereof the approbation and allowing of her
 Testament: And the power of granting the administration
 of all and singular the goods rights and credits of the
 said deceased and also the auditing the acct^s, Cal-
 culations and reckonings of the said administration
 and the final dismission and discharge from the same to
 me is manifestly known to belong. And that the
 Administration of all and singular the Goods Rights
 and Credits of the said deceased and her s^d Testament
 any manner of way concerning was committed unto
 Edmund Pellegrin, Barnaby Bull and Thomas
 Fairchild named Executor in the said Will and
 Testament, being first sworn of the Holy Evangelists.

They are to authorize and Impower you whose names are hereunderwritten to repair to such parts & places within that part of this Province that lies from Cape Fear South & West as you shall be directed unto by Edmund Bellinger, Barnaby Bull & Tho^s Fairchild Executors of the last Will and Testament of Ann Fairchild late of this Province deceased or any of them wheresoever any of the goods of the said Deceased are or do remain within the said parts and places which shall be shown to you by the s^d Edmund Bellinger, Barnaby Bull and Tho^s Fairchild, and there view and Appraise all and every the said Goods, being first sworn on the Holy Evangelists to make a full and perfect Inventory and Appraisal thereof and Return the same under your Hands (or any three of you) unto the Secretary's Office at Charles Town at or before the Tenth Day of August next ensuing
