 goods, rights and credits of the said Deceased and
 also the auditing the accounts, calculations & rec-
 onings of the said Administration and the final
 dismission and discharge from the same to me is
 manifestly known to belong, and that the Admini-
 stration of all and singular the goods, rights &
 credits of the said Deceased, and his Testament any
 manner of way concerning was committed unto
 Rowland Evans and Mary Ayres, named Executors
 in the said Will and Testament, being first sworn
 in the Holy Evangelists well and faithfully to
 Administer the same and to make a full and
 perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods,
 rights and credits of the said Deceased, & to exhibit
 the same unto the Secretary's Office at Charles-
 Town, at or before the Second Day of May next
 ensuing, and to render a true and just account,
 calculation & reckoning thereof, when thereunto

 year of his Majesty's Reign.
