 of this my last Will & Testament & I do hereby
 revoke disannul & make void all former
 Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made In
 Witness whereof I say I said William Elmes
 to this my last Will & Testament have set my
 hand & Seal the day and year above Written.

 in the Province of South Carolina Renter being in
 perfect mind and memory thank be to Almighty
 God. Therefore Calling to mind the mortality of my
 body and knowing that its appointed for all men
 once to dye Do make and Ordain this my last
 Will and Testament. That is to say Principally
 and first of all I give and recommend my soul
 unto the hands of God that gave it and my Body
 I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent
 and Christian manner as my Executors shall think
 fitt. As for my Worldly Estate Wherewith it hath
 pleased God to bless me with in this Life I
 give Ordain and dispose of the same in the
 following manner and form
 Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my children
 in Law John Betterson William Betterson and Mary
 Betterson one hundred Pounds Current money
 of the said Province to each of the said Bettersons.
 Item I give one hundred Pounds to be devised out
 of my Estate to the Free School of St. John's
 Parish and no other use but for a help to
 raise a Free School in the said Parish
 Item I give and bequeath unto the said Bettersons
 three feather beds that is to each one a bed such as
 my Executors shall think fitt.
 Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved
 Son
