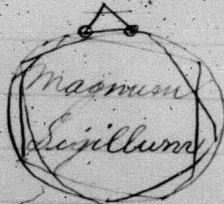

 and perform all such matters, and things as to the Office
 of Naval Officer in any of Our Colonies or Plantations
 in America doth in anywise appertain or belong
 To have and To hold the said Office of Naval
 Officer during our Pleasure, Together with all Fees
 Perquisites and Profits incident to the said Office.
 Witness Francis Nicholson Esq. Our Captain General
 and Governor in Chief in and over our Province of
 South Carolina and Town under Our Great Seal of
 our Province this Seventh day of June in the Year of
 Our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty
 One, and in the Seventh Year of Our Reign.
