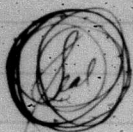


Now This Indenture Witnesseth

Receipt whereof the said William Scott doth
hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every
Part and Parcel thereof doth Acquit Release
and discharge the said Francis Holmes Sen^r
his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns
By these Presents As the said
William Scott hath Granted Bargained Sold
Alien Released and Confirmed and by
these Presents doth fully and absolutely
Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release and
Confirm unto the said Francis Holmes Sen^r
in his Actual Possession now being by
Vertue of a Bargain and Sale for one whole
Year to him thereof made by the said William
Scott for the Consideration of five Shillings
By Indenture bearing date the day next
before the day of the Date of these
presents to Commence from the day next
before

The said Francis Holmes Sen^r his Heires
and assigns from Time to Time and at all
times hereafter peaceably and Quietly
do Enter into have hold use Occupy Possess
and Enjoy the said Eleven hundred and
Twenty acres of Land and all and Singular
other the Premises herebefore mentioned
and Intended to be hereby granted and
Released and of Every part and parcel
thereof with their and every of their
Appurtenances without any the Lawfull
Let Suit Trouble Molestation Eviction
or Interruption of the said William
Scott his Heires or Assigns or any other
person or persons whatsoever Lawfully
Clayming or to Claym by Force or under
him and that Free and Clear and Freely
and Clearly and absolutely acquitted
Exonerated and Discharged by the said
William Scott his Heires and assigns
of and from all and all manner of
former and other Gifts Grants Bargains
Sales uses ands Intails Joyntures Dowries
Judgements Execution Charges and
Incumbrances

Incumbrances whatsoever had made done
Comitted or Suffered by the said William
Scott or any other person or persons whatsoever
the rent or rents from hence forth to grow
due and payable to the true and absolute
Lords and Proprietors of this Province
Only Excepted and Further that the said
William Scott and his Heires and all
and Every other person and persons
Lawfully Clayming or to Claym any
Estate right Title or Interest in or
to the said Eleven hundred and twenty acres
of Land and all and Singular
Other the Premises herebefore
mentioned and Intended to be hereby
Granted and Released or any part
or parcel thereof shall and will from
Time to Time and at all times
hereafter at the Reasonable request and
at the proper Cost and Charges in the
Law by the said Francis Holmes Sen^r
his Heires or Assigns make do acknow-
ledge Levy Execute or Cause and
Procure to be made done acknowledged

To M^{rs} Christian Scott

Whereas William Scott late of this Province deceased,
lately died Intestate having whilst he lived & at the time
of his death diverse Goods, Rights and Credits within the
Province aforesaid by means whereof the full disposition
and Power of Granting the Administration of all & Singular
the Goods, Rights and Credits of the said William
Scott deceased and also the Auditing of the Accounts
calculations and reckonings of the aforesaid Adminis-
tration and a final discussion of the same to me is
Manifestly known to belong & denoting that the goods,
rights and credits which were of the said deceased may
be well and truly administered, converted and disposed of
to pious uses do hereby grant unto you the said Christian
Scott (In whose fidelity in this behalf I very much Confide)
Full Power by the Tenour of these Presents to administer
the Goods, Rights and Credits of the said deceased which
he had in his Lifetime and at the time of his decease did
belong and to Ask, Collect, Levy, Recover and Receive the
Same And to pay the Debts in which the Deceased
stood Obligated, so far forth, as the said Goods, Rights
And

Charities from Cape, Fear South and West as you shall
 be directed unto by M^r. Christian Scott Administrator
 of all and singular the goods rights and Credits of
 William Scott late of this Province Deceased, Whereupon
 any of the Goods of the said deceased are or do remain
 within the said Ports and Places which shall be shewn
 to you by the said Christian Scott and there view and
 appraise all and every the said Goods bring first Sworn
 on the Oath. Evangelists do make a full and perfect Inven-
 tory and appraisement thereof and to return the same
 under your hands (or of any three of you) unto the Sec^{ry}
 Office at Charles Town at or before the Twenty first Day
 of September next Insuing.
