Memorandum. That on this thirty first day of July 1720
I personally came and appeared before me the said
named John Brown, George Baptiste and Robert
Booth who being duly sworn on the holy Evangelists
say that they and each of them were of soundly Mind
and did see the said Testator Forworn being signed
Published and Delivered the within Writing to see and
stand as and for his last will and Testament the day
of the date thereof and that the said Testator was of
sound and disposing mind and memory at the
same time.

In the Name of God amen. This twenty third day
of August in the seventh Year of the Reign of
our Sovereign Lord George. By the Grace of God
of Great Britain France and Ireland King
Defender of the Faith & in the Year of Our
Lord one thousand seven hundred and Twenty
I Peter Hermanion Camer late of Maryland
in the Province of North Carolina, but now of
the Parish of St. Chellip's Charles Town in the
Colony of North Carolina, in North America,

Wills Wright, being sick and weak of Body but of
sound and perfect mind and memory (thanks be
given to Almighty God for the same) taking into
consideration the uncertainty of this life upon earth
and being willing to settle things in Order, do make
constitute and appoint this my last will and Testament
hereby annulling and Revoking all and every other
former Wills and Wills, Testaments and Testam^{ts} heretofore
by me made either by Writing or other ways and this
only is to be taken for my last Will and Testament: and
done after and after recommending my soul to God
(who gave it) and hoping for his Pardon of all my
Sins, in and through the Merits and for the sake of
his only Son, Jesus Christ my Redeemer and my
Brother to the Earth to be Buried the next as to my
Burial hereafter named that I have next & herein
as for my Temporal Estate, which do hath pleased
God to bestow upon me, I do hereby give and bequeath
in full order and Dispose of the same in following
(that is to say) ————

First I will that all manner of Debts which of
right or in conscience I justly owe to any Person
or Persons whatsoever be well and truly paid within
reasonable time after my Death by any
Executors hereafter named.

I then I give and bequeath unto my Brother Eagle
Hermanion son of Camer also to my Brother Benjamin
Wybrausen, and likewise to my Sister Wybrausen
unto each and every of them whatever moiety or
hereafter at the time of my Death shall be owing
due to me, from any Person or Persons who soever
in Europe and the same to be divided & appointed
for & among my two said Brothers and Sister
according to the Customs of North Carolina.

I then I give & bequeath unto my said Brother Eagle
Hermanion my Dwelling House, all my Books, Papers
and

aforesaid unto her, her Heirs and Assigns for ever
and say With more particular is that out of the
same she pay unto her son William now living
the sum of Fifty Pounds Curr. money of the said
Colony, and further say with and Deceit is, that
if any dispute or Difference shall or may
happen to arise, about or concerning any
Injurers or Repinters Work w^h has been done
and performed by me for any Person or Persons
whatsoever in the said Colony, and the Accents
of the Value of the same not settled, or as yet
adjusted, that then such Dispute or Difference
may be referred to the determination of Richard
Gladman, Jonas Kuttner, John Lee all three of
Charles Town aforesaid Judges, or to the Deputies of
any two, upon their Oaths, to be administered to
them for that purpose, or to any of them that are living
Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
Sarah Child aforesaid to be my said Executrix of
this my Last will and Testament, and desiring
that Cap. Moses Willson would be an assistant
to her in the management and ordering of my
Funerals, In Testimony whereof I have
