And for the temporal Estate I have passed God
to bless me to, first I will that all my debts
be paid within convenient time after
my decease by my Executors and Executors hereafter
named.

Item I give & bequeath to my loving Brother John
Stewart five hundred acres of Land upon
which I will that part near the River be sold
to him & his heirs for ever & one half of the
other.

Item I give & bequeath to my loving Son John
Stewart all my Land upon the River except that
already given to my Brother John Stewart to
him my wife John Stewart and his heirs for ever, as
also one half of all my Estate of Personal to him my Son
John Stewart and his heirs for ever. In Case of his
Death the said Land of my Wife proceeds with
Child by me then the said Child shall be free to
enjoy the said Land my son John Stewart before
he comes of age & after his death of my Personal
Estate to the said Child and his heirs for
ever. And in case of my Son John Stewart dying before
the said age and my Wife proceeds to be with Child
by me then the said Land upon the River &
Combeha and my Son John's part of my
Personal Estate to fall to my Brother John Stewart.
