

Memorandum On the Twenty first day of March
 A.D. 1791 I personally came and appeared
 before me the Hon. James Moore Esq. J. of
 the County of South Carolina, James Leake
 & John Stearns Two of the Justices of the
 Peace, with attending duly sworn and sworn
 Evangelist of Almighty God & each of them
 say that they and each of them was Present
 Present and in their minds the above Testa-
 ment seal Publish and Declare the above
 Writings to be & Entail his Last Will and
 Testament and that at the time of his so doing
 he was of sound mind & memory and that
 Peter James Moore Minister subscribed his
 name and seal in their Presence
 sworn before me Ja. Moore

Carolina I the Name of God Amen I George
 Logan of Berkeley County in the Province of South
 Carolina being in perfect health of body and of sound
 mind and memory thanks to Almighty God first Do
 make, Ordain, Publish and Declare, Therefore
 to be and Entail my last Will and Testament
 hereby repealing and making Null & Void
 all former and other Wills and Testaments by me
 heretofore made, First and Principally, I
 commend my soul to Almighty God my
 Creator, and by believing that I shall receive
 full pardon and remission of all my sins and
 be saved by the precious Death & merits of my
 blessed Saviour and Redeemer Jesus Christ
 my body to the Earth from whence it came
 to be buried in due Order but not for my
 manner unto my Executors & Co-Executors

hereafter named, that I thought and intended
 and as touching such things as I have in the
 world have been pleased to bestow upon me, my Wife
 and Children & meaning is the same shall be my
 and disposed, as hereafter by this my Will is expressed
 Item 2^d My Will desire, I meaning is that the debts
 due to me here and in all other parts of the world
 whether as also the Rent of Lands, accruing from the
 Labour of the Slaves on the Plantation on which I
 live and where I now reside and the Slaves on the Plantation
 formerly used & known by the Name of the above
 my son George Logan and his management there
 shall be appropriated and I do appropriate the same
 for the paying & Discharging my just Debts and that
 no Legacies hereafter by me given or devised of
 any part of my Estate made, shall be paid or
 directed me till my said Debts be first satisfied & paid
 in whole Item 3^d My Will and Desire also is that
 both myself and my Wife Children be and I do hereby
 Ordain, that there shall be no maintenance out of the produce
 from the Labour of the Slaves of both the Plantations
 before mentioned until the Debts be fully paid and
 satisfied But in case any of them should be otherwise
 of having their Legacies hereafter by me given that
 they shall not otherwise their Legacies shall be obliged
 and I do hereby I do oblige them & every of them to pay
 out of their said Legacies a proportionable part of the
 my said Debts that shall be then due & owing as
 shall be required by my Executor & Co-Executors
 named Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my
 dear & Well beloved Wife of the above named
 Slaves (after my just Debts are fully paid and
 Discharged as above) by Name, George, Mary
 Joseph, Rapping, Jack, Jeffrey, Godi, George, Abraham
 Mervin, Quaco, Fortune, June, Adam, Flora, India

Shall be given to my said son George, the said
in which I have given and bequeathed
unto my said Loving Wife all the household
goods, as bedding, Dish, Pewter, Iron, Linnen
and Wearing of what kind I ever wish the said
and I wish that were actually and bona fide
before my Marriage to her. I likewise give &
bequeath unto her my said Wife all the stock
to her use in my said plantation where I now
reside that is to say Great Cattle, Horses, Mares & Hags
I also give unto my said Wife, Twenty Eight feet of
Land on the Bay adjoining to the Northward on land
belonging to my said Wife, Blackman, and
three Lots in Charles Town known by the Number
also two Lots at Beaufort
and known by the Number
bequeath & Promise I give to her and her heirs
for ever, All such provisions and it is the true
intent and meaning of this my last Will & Testament
that what is herein by me given to my said
Wife before she is and shall be in full of
all protection or protections to her heirs, or
Dower, that she may come to my said Estate
or any part thereof by any legal Estate, Usage
or means whatsoever. Item I give
Diverse & bequeath unto my son George, Twenty
Slaves (after my Debts are paid as
before provided) by Name Duke, Prince
a black man, London Backus, Prince, Jack, Will
Tom, Adam, Coffer, to them I have bought of
Capt. Fuder, Gyron, Malle, Carinda, Nadera,
Gyron, Little Luna, Mina, Mary & Jenny who
two were bought of Capt. Fuder to him I have
also give to him my said son George, the

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plantation he now resides upon
After a time formerly bought of the said
Containing by Plot and grants five Hundred and
Twenty Acres & it more or less to the mansion house
out house & all manner of Buildings whatsoever
thereunto belonging of also the stock, as Great Cattle
Mares, Sheep & Hags, all the furniture belonging to
the said house, be they of what kind or nature shall be
also my Plate & all my excepting such of the
bequeath & Promise I give to my son Patrick
be by me bequeathed and given to my son Patrick
and Daughter Helen Logan, I further give and
bequeath unto my said son George, two steel
Guns, two silver hilted sword, a hanger and
broadsword, and my Horse Iron, & all my Fire
Arms & Furniture, two years of Distillery & all
the on it is my said son George, also my said son
bequeath & Promise I give to him my said son
George & his heirs for ever, I provide and
it is my meaning that in any and all
George should go to our male issue, that my
Will is that the before bequeathed plantation of
Wadsworth to the mansion house & out house & all
shall be & River to my son Patrick and his
heirs & his and for want of such male heirs I
to my Daughter Helen and her heirs for ever.
Item I give Diverse & bequeath unto my
Patrick Logan, Twelve black men, who were
as paid as before provided by Name Peter, Dick
Indian Tutor, Glass, Pompey, John, Frank
Nanna, Nagar, Partinier, Indian Boy, Indya
Manna, with three Indians also a black man
Containing by Plot & grants, five Hundred &
