to my well beloved Brother Isaac Wright my  
Cowper & Seven hundred acres of land to him  
& his heirs for ever — Item I give to my  
Brother Isaac Wright Four hundred fourteen acres of  
land called by the name of Fairville Point to  
him & his heirs for ever — Item I give to my  
Brother Isaac Wright One Negro man named  
Mingo, One Negro woman named Betty one  
Negro girl named Nigga One Negro boy named  
Kerry to him & his heirs for ever — Item  
7000 to my Brother Isaac Wright One  
Barbados Gun one Trussing Gun & a pistol  
and three silver spoons — Item I give to my  
Sister Mary Moorely one Cow and Calf

herein set my hand at New Haven 25 day of July 1776
