and of sound mind & memory (Praised be God) do hereby
this my last Will and Testament set in manner the
following, hereby revoking all wills & Testaments
by me formerly made and unmade I am unto my
Soul to God that gave it, and my body to the Earth
to be decently Interred, according to the desire
of my Executors hereafter named in hopes of a
Resurrection through Jesus Christ my only Lord
& Saviour. —

And as to the Disposition of my Land & Estate
my Will and mind is that all my Good and Lawful
whatsoever be sold for the defraying my just debts
and funeral Charges, and that all the residue and
remaining Part of my Estate, after my said Debts
fully Discharged, shall be disposed of and managed
my Executors hereafter named to the best Advantage
according to their Judgment, for the only use & behoof
of my Beloved Daughter Mary M^r Murtry.

I do hereby request my whole Estate Real and Personal
in the Province aforesaid or elsewhere to my said
Daughter Mary M^r Murtry & to her Heirs for ever
I do will and appoint that my said Daughter be
to all & singular Executors after my Decease to sell
Effects whatsoever to her Grandfather Mr. Robert
Porter living in Bellinaghibe near Bellinaghibe in the
Kingdom of Ireland and do Demand and appoint
that said Mr. Robert Porter at his arrival of my
Daughter in Ireland, shall take into his care and
protection my said Daughter and my Effects to
be the sole and behoof of my said Daughter
until she shall arrive at the age of sixteen years

or until the day of marriage, and it is my Will that
in case the said Robert Porter do depart this life before
my said Daughter shall come to the age of sixteen
years or contracts Matrimony, then my Will is that
Mr. Robert Porter the Son of the deceased Robert Porter
shall take and is hereby Ordered, to take the whole care
and trust of my said Daughter, and all my Effects to
be the sole and behoof of my said Daughter until
the Limitations and restrictions aforesaid —

And in case my said Daughter should die before
she arrives at the age aforesaid or before she contracts
Matrimony, I bequeath and give all my Estate Real &
Personal into my beloved Sister Jane M^r Murtry
living near Downmore in the County of Down in
the Kingdom of Ireland & to her Heirs for ever and I
do Order and appoint that my Executors hereafter named
take special care that my said Effects be transmitted
to my Sister in case of Daughter's Death as aforesaid.

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary
M^r Murtry a Gold Ring of Value Twenty Shillings
standing in Lieu of her Dower & in full satisfaction
of claim to any part of my Estate Real or Personal
Debts, Dues or Demands, whatsoever, this being
Quant to a Verbal contract agreed upon between us
both and was actually executed on the part of my said
Wife before marriage, therefore it is my last intention
& meaning notwithstanding any Statute or Law to
the contrary that my said wife shall have & enjoy it
hereby settled, from every part & share and thing
belonging or appertaining to my Estate Real or
Personal aforesaid except a Gold Ring of the Value
aforesaid.

Lastly, I do hereby request Cap^t Robert Fenwick
Mr. Michael Deasy & Mr. James M^r Murtry to be Executors
in trust for my said Daughter Mary M^r Murtry in testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 1st day of June
