that all Acts apreaid to be my said Decrees of
this my Last will and Testament, and desiring
that Cap^t James Wilson would be an asstant
to her, in the managing and ordering of my

any other unexpected this fortune. That is the case
above mentioned are not sufficient to support her
wants & necessities. That then, and in such case by and
to the widow and Consent of my Executors, herein
after named, that any Part of the above mentioned
Estate, shall and may be disposed of for and towards
the support & maintenance of her, if she shall remain
a Widow but in case she shall marry then to hold
and Receive the uses of the above mentioned and
nothing more. And I do by these presents make
bequeath to my wife and appoint my Loving
Friends John Fairchild & Richard Fairchild
to be my Executors to this my last will and
Testament. And truly my will is after the death
of my Loving wife Mary Squire, that all and
every part and parcel of the remaining and residue
of the above mentioned Estate, all just debts and
funeral Charges first being paid and Discharged
shall be disposed of by my above named Exors to
such charitable uses as they shall think fit. I

Ordain this my last Will and Testament that it to my
Principally and first of all I give and recommend my

Decent Manner, at the discretion of my Executors, nothing
detracting unto the great Resurrection. I shall receive
the same again by the mighty Power of God and as
touching such Goods by Estate which with its hark
I leave God to bestow as He will in His Life I give
dispose of the same in the following manner. I give
Imprimis I give and bequeath to the said Robert
my son and Child thirty foot front of my lot that is
White Point and the shop that is on the N. West side
of the said lot to her and her heirs for ever
