

First my wife and Servant is that all my
Just Debts in this Province or elsewhere, and
Funeral Charges, be fully discharged and paid
by Executors hereafter named, and in Order
Whereunto I will and Ordain my whole Tract of
Land commonly known by the name of Mac-
Daniels Plantation, to be sold by Auctioneers and
that what money there shall remain of that
it shall be sold for, after my Just Debts are
fully satisfied, my will is that the same shall
be equally divided between my beloved Wife &
among Children, & equals share to each of them

I give bequeath and Devise unto my Eldest
beloved Son James, and to the Heirs of his Body
lawfully begotten, all that Tract of Land whereon
now lives upon Condition that he shall with
truly pay unto his Brother John and George
two thirds of what my money my said Plantation
shall be valued at to wit in the space of five
years, after my Decease, but if my son James
should refuse or neglect to pay the same I

do in that my said Plantation shall be divided
into three equal parts, viz. one for each of my sons
James, my wife and Servant is and hereby declare
that all my property and Estate of what kind soever
and all that my Personal Estate be equally
divided between my beloved Wife and Children all
after my Decease to each of them in equal shares -
to Division shall be made to in twelve Months
after my Decease by my Executors hereafter
named except my young Daughter I hereby give to
my beloved wife for her sole and singular use

Lastly I make constitute ordain and appoint my
said beloved wife Mary Fitzgerald, Mrs. Thos. Allen and
Mr. James Deane my Son in Law, Executors of this
my last will and Testament in Witness
whereof

be daily paid and satisfied

3ly I do give and bequeath unto my loving Wife
Francis all my Estate both Real and Personal
during her Widowhood the Education and
bringing up my Children until my son Jonathan
Ward comes to the Age of Twenty one Years old
except the Marry before she hath chazing them
for us

4ly I will that a just appraisement be given and a
true Inventory made of my Goods and bequeath
unto my son Jon. Ward all my Estate both

Real and Personal my meaning is that he
should enjoy all my Estate that is among land and
all my Goods by Name in these Real parson
that is to say Jack Hanna Wolt and Boby

Alonso Diana, Mary pater, Salver and John
and Hanna Caty Immi and Peter with all their
Inheritance and all my Cattle to their Inheritance
my meaning is that he should enjoy the Very

same Effects that is before named for ever to
him and his Heirs Provided he or they paying
to his Mother her Third which becomes her
just due by Law and also he or they paying to

the rest of his Brothers and Sisters an equal part
of my Personal Estate according to the
appraisment afore said that is to his Brothers

generally as they shall arrive or come to the
Age of one and Twenty Years (to have
Equal)

Equal parts and also to his Sister and
Wife or come to the Age of Eighteen Years old or be
Married their Equal Parts

I will that my said Son Jonathan Ward or his Heirs
maintain the rest of his Brothers and Sisters in meat
Drink and apparel and also give them Education and
Darning according to his Ability he or they not
Charging them for any particular

6ly I will that if my son Jonathan Ward dye under
Age or without Wife or Issue Lawfully begotten then
his Brother next by birth to enjoy my Estate he
performing the Conditions as his Brother ward can
do in every respect, come to the youngest of my Sons
in Case of Mortality the eldest dying without Lawful
Issue he performing the Conditions aforesaid in
every respect

7ly I will that if any of my Children die under Age
or without Wife or Issue Lawfully begotten then his
or her part be Equally Divided amongst the rest
of my Children

8ly I nominate constitute and appoint my said
Wife Francis to be Administrixatrix of this my present
last will and Testament and for Executors of the same do
execute and appoint my Trusty and well beloved
Friends W. John Jones, W. John Oldfield and W.

David Ravenel, revoking and making void
all other former Wills or Wills or Testaments heretofore
made or intended to be made (confirming this and
no other to be my last will and Testament in Writings
whereof I have set my hand and Seal this Twentieth
third day of September Anno Domini one thousand
seven hundred and Nineteen

sick and appeared before the within named Deeds
Darius, Ann Greenleaf and Isabella Greenleaf who being

Testator John Fitch sign seal Publish and Declare the
within Writing to be and stand as and for his last
Will and Testament the day of the Date hereof and that
the said Testator was of sound and disposing mind
at the time of the same time

I give and bequeath to Martha Stone my
Sister one Gold Chain
I give to my wife beloved Child one at my personal
estate to be Equally to be Divided to them when they
come to age or to their Marriage, and in case it
should please God to Take them hence before they
come of age or married, I give and bequeath that same
estate as aforesaid to my Sister Martha Stone
that she is now Legally with and does and to my Brother
Jesse Child and his Heirs for ever, I give likewise
to my Brother Joseph Jones one Indian man
named Primas to be taken from the estate at the
Death of my Children

I likewise constitute make and Ordain my
Brother Sam: Jones and my Brother John
Stone to be the Executors of this my last will and
Testament: and I do hereby utterly disannul revoke
and Disallow all and every other former Testam:
will and Legacies Requests and Executors by me
in any ways before this time made, Willed and
Bequeathed, Ratifying and Confirming this to
be my last will and Testament, In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal the day and Year above Written
