known by the Name of Turkey hills & the other
containing one hundred & fifty eight acres known
by the Name of Hills
Item I give & bequeath to my Loving Daughter
Edith Twenty Cows & Hogs to be taken out of my
Stock of Cattle & at my Expence on Apheos River
Item I give & bequeath unto my Loving Daughter
Martha Two Hundred Acres of Land on Boston Island
being the Plantation on which Mr. Tho: Brewer
Died
Item I give & bequeath unto my Loving Son John
Eight Slaves by Name Roger, ~~great~~ Will,
great

great Eff. (Cato, Little Eff. Belle, Isaac, Maria &
Milly
Item I give & bequeath unto my Loving Daughter

Item I give & bequeath to my Loving Daughter
Martha Eleven Slaves by Name Lucy, Drane,
Pops, Onford, Doby, Dick, Jack, Manico, Hagie,
Calamina & Maria
Item I give & bequeath to my Loving Son John
all my Stock of Cattle Hogs & Horses, that I
have on my Expence on Apheos River excepting
the Twenty head of Cows & Hogs that I have
given to my Daughter Edith
Item I do give & bequeath unto all my Children also
my household goods to be Equally Divided
among them including such things of these
kinds as they or some of them have had already
Item I do give and bequeath all that part of my
Personal Estate that is beyond the Season the
Inno called the John Adventure to be Equally
Divided amongst them
Item I will that my Cows that is on the Ground
and Cattle hogs & Hogs (on Boston Island)

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bequeathed and that my wife be paid out of the
my now arriving here from and all that I have
and bequeathed by my personal estate. I do give
bequeathed by my loving friend Benjamin
also to Robert Dearborn, whom I do constitute &
appoint the Executor of this my last will &
testament.
And I do hereby revoke & annul all that I
have before made in this my last will
and testament. In witness whereof I have
signed my hand and seal the first
day of June the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred & eight.

he comes of age and my Wife proceeds with to be with
by me then the said Land to be given to the said
John Stewart and my son John Stewart part of my
Personal Estate to be to my Brother John Stewart
