 after my death & shall be now belonging or may in any
 manner be due or Demand.
 I do appoint & constitute Ebenezer Goodrich
 my sole Executor to this my last will and Testament
 and I do hereby Disavow all other will or Wills former

 punctually fulfilled as in manner & form following
