 Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner
 & form following (that is to say) first said Principally
 I commend my Soul into the hand of Him who is
 living through His merits passion and Merits of His
 Only Son our dear Redeemer or Jesus Christ He
 have forgiven and pardon of all my sins and to
 Intercede for my life my body I bequeath to
 His Church to be decently buried at the discretion of
 my Executors here in after named, and as touching
 my Temporal Estate as it hath pleased God of His
 Infinite Mercy to bestow upon me I give and
 Dispose thereof as followeth. First I will that all
 my Just Debt and funeral Expenses be first paid
 & charged. Next I give and bequeath unto my
 Loving Daughter Jane Holbeatch the sum of three
 hundred Pounds part money of Carolina to be paid
 unto her by the Treasurers of the said Province
 when she shall come to the age of twenty one years
 Next I bequeath and give all my Estate both
 Real and Personal, what so ever and where so ever

I give devise and bequeath to my Loving Wife Anne
 Holbeatch and to the said Anne with their heirs and assigns
 to their heirs and assigns forever or for ever of my
 Devise to remain them, Heirs & assigns forever but in case
 my said Wife shall die carry in the said estate the
 husband of a boy, shall happen to die before the age of
 Twenty One years or if a girl before the age of Eighteen
 years on Day of Marriage then I give the whole to my
 said Wife. Her heirs and assigns administrators or assigns
 forever & I do hereby constitute my said wife to be
 Guardian of said Child, who will be the husband of
 the said Anne to the age of Twenty One years or
 Marriage, in case she so long continue my wife or
 but in case of my wife's Death or Marriage or by my
 my son Michael Bowston Guardian and Heir
 I do hereby appoint & nominate the said Michael
 Bowston sole and sole Executor of this my last will
 Testament hereby revoking all former and other
 wills by me at any time heretofore made and to
 publish and Declare this to be and stand as and for
 my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I the

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I do hereby certify that I have been pleased to bestow in his Life I give &
devise bequeath all that Square of Land upon Norwest
-bury of the Ferry the containing five Acres Square
to two Acres and a half of Land Butting on the River
Bay and also the Marsh two Chains and a half between
the Bay & the River as it appears in the Town Plat to
my Trustees hereafter named in trust to them and their
Successors forever to be let out by them for a sledge
or University when any Civil and Christian the Person
or People think it fitting for that use and put to use
other use and penalty of one hundred pounds of Sterling
English money to the Owners of Peter Berry Town & my
son Isaac Child and his Heirs to enjoy and to have &
to hold the profits of the aforesaid Gift until it be
paid for the aforesaid use. Item I give and
bequeath to my son Isaac Child two Lots of Land
one to Ferry Street containing half an acre each Lot
two Chains long and one Chain wide each Lot over for the
breadth which is one acre Butting on the River Bay
together with the River Marsh between the Bay and the
River. Item I give and bequeath one acre and a
half of Land for to build a Church or Chapel upon it &
for a Burying Place for the Inhabitants of Haverhill
Town and all to be in the Western and Eastern Branch of
Cooper River as it is bounded out to Peter Town and
a cedar fence both the Timber Trees growing or may
hereafter grow in the Church Yard and also the harborage
& meadows I give to my son Isaac Child and his
Heirs forever to be sown or sowed and to be kept
the Church Yard weeded & clean & smooth from hoggs
digging upon penalty of Forfeiting all the Timber &
Tree Knobs & galls to my Trustees and them to
dispose of it to whom they shall think fitting. Item I
give & bequeath nine Acres of Land a square in the
middle of the Town as it appears in the Town Plat
for a market place. Item I give and bequeath
