commit. And the said Joseph Wragg Tutor and Guardian of the
said Jane Kays, Do by these presents make and Undertake, charging you that
you maintain her in most Thrift, without Lazing, Schooling, Pleathing-
and Education as may be fitt, for her degree and Quality during the
time she shall be under your Tutor and Guardianship, or during the Time
of her Minority and till you inquire into and take care and Charge
of
