Whereas Eleazar Wright now of this Province, Widower, on Behalf of Robert Wright his Son, a Minor, of the Age of Nine Years hath appeared before Me and His Majesty's Council in the said Province, and by Petition prays (for which I have taken Oath) That John Wright of the said Province, Merchant, the said Minor's Brother, may be appointed Guardian, to look after and take into his Care and Management the said Minor's Interest and Estate of what nature or kind soever, And Whereas the said John Wright hath likewise appeared as aforesaid, and accepted the Charge of the said Guardianship, Know Ye therefore That for the better securing of the said Robert Wright and Estate whatsoever, and for the more careful maintenance and Education of the said Robert Wright, Infant, Orphan and Child of, John Wright (as aforesaid) late of this Province deceased, Out of the Confidence of the Integrity, care and uprightness of the said John Wright, (for which I have taken Oath) in His Majesty's Secretaries Office in this Province, the said Guardianship and Education of the said Robert Wright is committed, and he the said John Wright Tutor and Guardian of the said Robert Wright is made and named. Whereby the said John Wright is Impowered and Charged to Inquire into, demand, Seek for, Levy, require, recover, receive and take into His Care, Charge and

Management all the Estate, Right Interest and dues of the said Robert Wright whatsoever, and when years the same is or may be, and to cause the said John Wright to be Maintained and Educated in all things as becometh his age and Quality during his Minority or the time he shall be under the tuition and Guardianship of him the said John Wright, and to do all other things as a Guardian by Law may or ought to be done, to render a true and faithful account of all the Money and Goods whatsoever belonging to the said Robert Wright, which shall come to his hands and possession, for into the hands and possession of any other person or persons for him, when he shall be therunto required by the said Guardian or Guardians as shall hereafter be chosen for or by the said Robert Wright, and duly authenticate, or to the said John Wright when he shall come of age to demand and receive the same by Law.

 his Minority, or the time he shall be under the Tutorship and Guardianship of
 him the said John Wright, and to do all other things (as a Guardian
 by Law may or ought to, being obliged to render a true and faithful account
 of all the Money and Goods whatsoever belonging to the said Richard
 Wright, which shall come to his hands and possession, or into the hands and
 possession of any other person or persons for him, when he shall be thereunto
 required. By such Tutorship or Guardians as shall hereafter be chosen by the
 said Richard Wright, and lawfully authorized, or to the said Richard Wright
 when he shall come of Age to demand and receive the same by Law.
