William White makes to the auditing of the act of Calculation & Recquisition of the aforesaid Ammon & a true Disposition of the same to me is manifestly known to Becong & Yisiring that the goods Rights & Credits which by reason of the S. Deed may be well and truly accounted & converted & vizuald & do hereby grant unto you the S. William Bull in whose fidelity tenor of this instrument to administer the goods rights & Credits of the S. Deed & to him in his life time & at the time of his Death & before & so as to collect & recover the same to pay the debts in goods rights & Credits so far forth as the S. Order of Law being first observed on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God to make a full & perfect Inventory thereof Town & order to be recorded on or before the tenth day of March next ensuing & to render a true & just Account Calculation & Recquisition of your S. Ammon when thereunto required by us and our Constituto you the said Rights & Credits of the S. Deed by these presents In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the xixth day of November anno Domini 1725 & in the twelfth year of his Majesties Reigne

The Last Will & Testament of Nicholas Stevens Esq. Dated 1725

In the Name of God Amen. I Nicholas Stevens of Charles Town in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina being sick and weak in Body but of sound Mind and Memory Thanks be Hereof to Almighty God do make Contain this my last will and Testament in Manner following. That is to say, First I call & bequeath my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God hoping for a glorious Resurrection through the Merit of my blessed Lord and Redeemer Jesus Christ and my Body to the Earth to be buried in decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors herein after named and as to what worldly Goods it hath pleased God to bestow me I dispose of the same in these Manners following. Imprimis I will that my Executors herein after named do pay or cause to be paid all my just Debts. Item my Will & that immediately after my Decease my Executors do hire out my Negro man named Jack and my Negro woman Flora, and that the clear Money arising from the

Part of the said Negros for the Term and space of two years be equally divided amongst John Bulbrys three Children share & share alike and that at the Expiration of the said Term of Two Years the said Negros & the entire Property of them be to my Executors & their Heirs for ever to be equally divided between them share & share alike.

Item I do hereby give, devise and bequeath unto John Barkdale Esq^r and M^r John Brand Thon Hart by appoint Executors of this my last Will and Testament and to their Heirs for ever all my lands and Tenements, Goods and Chattels and all other my real and personal Estate whereever lying & being in the Province aforesaid to be equally divided between them share & share alike, And do hereby revoke all former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & Seal to this my Will on this 1st Oct of Christ 1725 Day February 1725
