having now attained to the of 21 years & the said Anne Davis being desirous
to make a Division of her said Husbonds Estate & Effects, for the Benefit

Of the said Children, according to their respective Interests therein, & was therefore prayed, if I would appoint Proper Persons to Share & Divide the said Estate, & to pay & Deliver over such part thereof to the Pet. & her Children (who are now come of Age) as by Law they are intitled unto. Therefore Reposing special Trust & Confidence in you if said Ralph & David John Herbert, William, Dry, Benj. Wareing & John Moor & Do hereby Authorize & Impower you or any three of you to View Appraise & Value Share Alloit & Divide all y^e Personall Estate & Effects of y^e said David Davis decess'd One third part to y^e said Anne Davis his Widow & the other two third parts thereof for the equal use & Benefit of all y^e said Children (now living) and your Doings therein you shall cause to be Certified under your hands, & if same (to these Presents annexed) to me Return at the Councile Chamber in Charles Town on or before the first day of August next for my Confirmation & allowance as to Justice shall appertain & according to Law in that case made & Provided: given under my hand & Seal of Office this sixth day of June 1726, in the Twelfth year of his Majesties
