NOW all men by these presents that David Dowsy of
South Carolina Indian Soldier for the better securing the
payment of the several Sums of money which I am indebted
to John Fenwick of Charles town Merchant & for and in
consideration of the sum of ten Shillings Currant money
to me in hand paid by the said John Fenwick before the date
hereof and for diverse other good causes & Considerations me
thereunto moving have bargained & sold And by these presents

Do in plain and open market Bargain sell and Deliver unto
the said John Fenwick Seven Pack horses & all other my personal
Estate Whatsoever & Wheresoever Whither this same consists
in horses Deer skins Furrs goods or other effects and all my
Estate Right Title Interest & Demand of in & to the same
I hold the same to the said John Fenwick his heirs assigns &
assigns as his and there own proper goods and Chattels forever mine
And I the said David Dowsy the above bargained premises &
every of them unto the said John Fenwick his heirs assigns and
assigns against all persons Whomsoever shall or will Warrant
for ever defend by these presents. Provided always that if I the said
David Dowsy do and shall well and truly pay unto the said
John Fenwick his heirs or assigns all such Sums of money
as I now owe & am indebted unto him then this bill of sale shall
be void & of none effect. And I am upon payment of such
Sums of money to have the said prebargained premises
returned to me otherwise to be and remain in full force &
Effect. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
this thirteenth day of December In the thirteenth year of his
Majesty's Reign Anno of Dom: 1726.
