This Indenture made the 16th day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Twenty Six the Twelfth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George, by the grant of God of great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. Between Nehemiah Partridge & Margaret his Wife of the one part and Francis Le Gras Esqr & Daniel Green of the other Merchants of the other part. Whereas by a certain bill of Sale & deed of Mortgage bearing date the 1st day of June in the said year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Twenty Six the said Nehemiah Partridge & Margaret his wife for the true purpose of the payment of a certain Obligation bearing even date & therein recited whereby they were firmly bound to the said Francis Le Gras Esqr the parcel sum of Two thousand Nine Hundred Ninety seven pounds fifteen shillings & six pence current money conditioned for the payment of Twelve Hundred and Ninety eight Pounds seven shillings & six pence current money to the said Francis Le Gras Esqr his Executors assigns or Assignes at or upon the 1st day of June next after the date thereof and for the more secure payment of the said sum of money as also for the further Confirmation of the same of present then in hand paid by the said Francis Le Gras Esqr they the said Nehemiah Partridge & Margaret his Wife did give grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Francis Le Gras Esqr, One Negro woman named Abba & four Negro Girls named Lady Polly Tarry & Hannah & also a Negro boy named Adam & the said two Negro Slaves before mentioned to him the said
