Bond of Gibbes to Samuel Penhallow

I know all Men By these presents That I Henry Gibbs
 Late of the Office of 1st Justice in the Island of Barbados Esq^r. But now
 residing in Charlestown in the Province of S^c Carolina am led &
 firmly bound unto Samuel Penhallow Master & Comm^{rs} of the Ship
 Royal Gally to Edward Nicholls & Henry Bullard both of the Island of
 Barbados appt^d Merchants in the Summe of three Thousand pounds &
 Good money of Great Britain to be payd to the sd^{rs} Sam^l Penhallow & Ed^{ward} Nicholls

Benjamin Bullard, or either of them their or either of their Executors, Administrators, Assigns or Assignees to the sd^{rs} payment well & truly to be made I bind
 my self my Heirs, Executors, Administrators, Assigns or Assignees by these presents sealed to my
 Seal to date the Twentieth day of October in the Year of Our said One
 Thousand seven hundred & Twenty five

Whereas the above named Samuel Penhallow being sometime
 in the Month of August last past at the Island of Barbados at his sd^{rs} Ship the
 Royal Gally did before his Departure shew according to the Laws & Usage
 Custom of these Islands become bound & firmly bound together with the
 Edward Nicholls & Henry Bullard jointly & severally unto Henry Gibbs Esq^r
 Governor of the sd^{rs} Island in the private Summe of Two Thousand pounds Sterl^{ing} or
 some such other great Summe to be paid them underwritten That his sd^{rs}
 Samuel Penhallow should not depart with his People from nor carry off the
 sd^{rs} Island, any Tithe or thereof, Freeman, Servants or Slaves, without a
 Ticket from the Governor or proper for the time being or to that of the
 like Effect as in & by the sd^{rs} Bond to be given to be remaining in the
 sd^{rs} Office in the Island of Barbados aforesaid, Wherein thereunto being had
 Date & more fully & at Large appear. And Whereas the said
 Henry Gibbs sometime in the Month of August last past did come aboard
 the sd^{rs} Samuel Penhallow to transport himself by the sd^{rs} Ship, the sd^{rs} Gally
 from Barbados aforesaid to the Province of S^c Carolina with fifty
 White Slaves without obtaining from the sd^{rs} Governor or Secretary of the
 Island for his sd^{rs} Passage such a Ticket or Tickets as by
 or are required to be given by the Laws & Customs of the Island aforesaid
 By reason whereof the sd^{rs} Bond hath been since put in suit agst the said
 Edward Nicholls & Henry Bullard or one of them, or is liable to be; &
 the sd^{rs} Samuel Penhallow is a Newry Subject & liable to the Penalty there
 to be levied hereafter his sd^{rs} two Partners on Account of their becoming bound to him
 as aforesaid: Now the Conditions of this Obligation is such That if the
 said Henry Gibbs or his Executors, Administrators, Assigns or Assignees shall from time to
 time & at all times hereafter well & truly have kept & indemnify the said
 Samuel Penhallow, Edward Nicholls & Henry Bullard or any of them their
 either of their Heirs, Executors, Administrators, Assigns or Assignees Goods & Chattels
 of & from the payment of the sd^{rs} Summe of Two Thousand pounds Sterl^{ing}
 or any part thereof & of & from all Costs, Charges, Damages & Expenses
 whatsoever which they the sd^{rs} Samuel Penhallow, Ed^{ward} Nicholls & Henry Bullard
 or any of them have hitherto sustained, & shall justly & or shall or may bear, suffer,
 sustain or be put unto, on & in respect of the sd^{rs} Bond not having obtained Legal &
 Regular Ticket or Tickets for himself & Slaves as aforesaid & of & from all other
 Bond
