Rusbelt his Executors Administrators and assigns to his and their own proper Uses and Purposes for ever, And I the said Ann Loydall my Executors Administrators and every of us the said three Negroes Named Margery Maria and John unto the said Alexander Rusbelt his Executors Administrators and assigns Against all People shall and Will Warrant and for Ever Defend, In Witnes Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
