I signify I will that all my just debts and Funerals Expenses be truly paid and satisfied

Item I will Ordain that my Executor & Executors hereafter named shall dispose of all that piece or parcel of a Down Lot situated the Day of Charles Town containing alliventy Eight Feet in front with the full depth thereof being the Southermost part of a lot known in the Model of the said Down Lot by the Number the three together with all the Plat lying before the same on Water March which said piece or parcel of a Down Lot was and conveyed to me by Martha Logan in part of a portion with my Wife together with all the Houses Out houses & other Buildings thereon erected standing & being And for that purpose I do hereby authorize & empower my said Executors & Executors the Survivor of them to alien & Convey the said Piece or part of a Down Lot with the Appurtenances unto such person or persons as they shall think fit in Fee Simple and my Will is that they apply & dispose of the moneys arising by the Sale hereof to the Payment and Discharging of such Debts

Item I give and devise unto my Son William Blahewy and his Heirs Assigns for Ever One Lot Lying without the Gates of Charles which Purchased of Patrick Logan Deceased and Whereas by an Agreement between me and George Logan Esq. the said George hath covenanted to perfect the Conveyance of the said Lot & Desire is that he will Convey & Assign the same in Fee Simple unto myself or my Son William And my further Will is that my beloved Wife Sarah Blahewy shall be minded to build a new Lot & Improve the same then and on that Express Condition & Consideration my Will is that she hold & Enjoy

The same during the term of her natural life I Give & Devise unto my Daughter Anne Blahewy her Heirs Assigns for Ever one Lot in Back Port Town in Port Royal being the Corner lot and known by the Number Twenty One Lastly I Give and bequeath unto my Dearly Beloved Wife Sarah - All the Rest and Residue of my Estate whatsoever to be applyed towards the maintenance & Education of my Children I Give unto Charles Hart & Benjamin White her Executors of them All Mourning Ring

And I hereby nominate constitute & appoint John Daniel Gent. & my Dearly beloved Wife Sarah Blahewy Esq. & Esq. of this my Last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand Seal the first Day of July in the Year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Twenty Seven
