upon me I do give and bequeath as follows


To my Beloved wife Margaret Heppatrick after my

that Stock. Item I do hereby will and desire to give
I do Give and bequeath to my beloved Son Thos. Heppatrick
Now at the Cuthaibus four Cows & Calf & two Mares & Colts to
be taken likewise out of the said Stock and one negro fellow
named Carolina. Item I do give and bequeath to my Son Alexander Heppatrick
now at the Cuthaibus Twenty pounds Cursancy and to my
Daughter Elizabeth Heppatrick now at the Cuthaibus Thirty
Pounds Cursancy for to Raise which money I desire that one
horse may be sold out of the said Stock. Item I do likewise give and bequeath to my dear Beloved wife
Margaret One Negro Wench Called Sabina and to the Child
she is now bigg with one negro wench Called Nan if it
should please God the Child shall live.

I do likewise will that at the Death of my Wife Margaret
the Child she is now bigg shall Inherit all the Estates hereby
Bequeathed to my said Beloved wife Margaret & in Care
that Child shall not live than to my son Thomas
now at the Cuthaibus and his heirs forever. Item I do likewise give and bequeath to my Beloved wife
