the Part of these Depositors knowledge & which and
Further that they together with Jane Locke Signed their
Names as Trustees in the presence of the Faktor

in that world, Date which God through his infinite Goodness
has pleased to bestow with and that I shall be any way minded
at the time of my Death be it either real or Personal or any
other kind Soccer I give and Bequeath the same unto my
dear loving wife Mary Shrewsbury to hold unto my said wife
during her life & forever. And I Do nominate and appoint my
wife Mary Shrewsbury to be whole and sole Executive of this
my Will & do revoke all other or former Wills by me at any time
before made, declaring this to be my only last Will & Testament
In witness whereof I have signed Edward Shrewsbury Rectorunto
Smyrna & seal this 18th day of May Anno Dom 1739/40 And in
the 34th Year of the reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the Second
King of Great Britain etc.

my last Will & Testament in Manner & form following vizt First and

from my Body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner
in hope of a joyfull Resurrection to receive reward for all my
sin through the merits of our Redeemer & Saviour Jesus Christ
and as touching such worldly Estate wheresoever it hath pleased

me to bestow the same I give and bequeath unto my Brother Jeremiah Morgan
with his wife and children the sum of Two hundred Crownes of that Country Money
as in the hands of Mr. Abraham Davis in the Williams
Island & his heirs for ever Then I give and bequeath the
Two Sisters Magdalena Jacquerry & gotten wife One
Crown each of that same Country money above mentioned
left by them & their heirs for ever which lies in the same hands of
Will & Davis that after my just debts and funeral charges above
paid out of what effects I am possessed in this parish of St Philipps
Town & Island Carolina may be left to the best advantage of the money

I appoint that Mr. Salomon Legarde Sen^r C. M^r Jaiah &
of this Parish to be my Executor My Will is that all the effects
left off in this province may be equally divided in three parts
third unto Peter Fellow of this Parish One third Salomon
one third Jaiah Brugget both of this Parish to be possessed
as they think proper In witness whereof I have set my
Seal the fifth day of September One thousand Seven hundred
sixty nine
