29 day of March in the Year of Our Lord One thousand seven hundred  
& Thirty & Seven Isaac Stewart being but Weak of Body but  
perfect Mind and Memory Thanks be to almighty God therefore  
coming to Mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is  
appointed for man once to die Do make & Ordain this my Last Will  
Testament That is to say principally and first of all I  
will & command my Soul into the hands of God that gave it Hoping  
through the merits Death and Passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ  
to have full and free pardon & forgiveness of all my sins & in his  
waking life And my Body I commit to the earth to be  
sunderly buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named  
nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the  
same again by the mighty Power of God And as touching such  
worldly Goods and Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Blest me  
with in this Life I Give Demise and dispose of the same in the  
following manner & form That is to say first I will that all those  
debts & dutys as I do owe in right or Conscience to any manner of  
Person or Persons whatsoever shall be well and truly paid and  
settled or otherwise to be paid in convenient time after my  
death by my Executors hereafter named Item I give and  
bequeath unto my loving wife Elizabeth Stewart Five hundred  
pounds Current Money of South Carolina to be paid to her out of  
estate after my death Otherwise one negro Woman named  
which is now of my possession One Indian Slave One
