Living I Give Devise and bequeath the said Slaves and
their Issue and increase to and among my three other
Grandchildren Richard Elias and Mary Clifford to be
Equally divided between them share and share alike
if my said Granddaughter Hannah Skinner shall happen

The Twentieth Day of May in the Year of Our Lord 1768
I Henry Jackson of the Province of South Carolina in Colleton
County Planter being very Sick and Weak in Body but
of perfect mind & Memory thanks be Given to God for it
and Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing
it is appointed for all Men Once to dye DO Make and
Ordain this my Last Will and Testament That is to
Say Principly and first of all I Give and Recommend to
the Care to be buried in a Christian like and Decent
manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting

But at the General Resurrection I shall Receive the
same again by the mighty power of God and as touching
my worldly Estate wherein it hath pleased God to
Bless with in this Life I Give Devise and dispose of
the same in the following manner and form Imprimis
My Will is that all the Estate be kept together till my
son Henry comes to the age of Twenty one Years then the
Estate to be divided as follows. Item I Give to my Dear by
Beloved Wife the Use of all my lands during the time she
remains my Widow and no longer Item I Do likewise
Give and bequeath to my Dear by Beloved Wife and to her
Heirs for ever One third part of all my money & Chatties
Household Goods and Moveables whatsoever is now belonging
to me to be divided at the time aforesaid Item I have in
Given to my well beloved son William Jackson already
the portion I intend for him I do hereby Cut him off (with)
and Give him Only Ten Pounds Current of this Province
to be raised and Levied out of the Estate when the same
is divided Item I Give and Bequeath to my
well beloved sons Reginald James John & Henry
and to their Heirs for ever all and singular my lands
Messuages and Tenements by them freely to be enjoyed
