 Executor to see this my last Will and Testament duly fulfilled and
 signed with my Witness or have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the nineteenth day of May in the twelfth Year of the Majesty of King George
 the third 1738.

in William Leaw Swamp Containing as by Grant One thousand five
hundred acres and also One other Tract of five hundred acres
