

I, John Green Father of Susanah & Elizabeth Green
 Behaved & Said, That is to say That The Said Susanah Do agree
 that her Said Sister Elizabeth have & enjoy the one half of the
 Said Land when the Said Elizabeth Shall arrive to the age
 of Twenty years Then My Will is That all The Real Estate
 & Remainder of My Estate Both Real & personal Goods & Chattels not
 Sworn Before & be by my Executors Equally Divided Between
 The Said Susanah & Elizabeth Green Daughter of Said John Green
 when They shall arrive to The age of Twenty years But if it should
 Happen That my Said Kinswoman Susanah & Elizabeth should Die
 or Depart this Life Before they arrive to the Age of Twenty
 years Then my Will is That all my Movable as personal
 Estate be Immediately Sold to the Highest Bidder, & the one third
 Part of the amounts thereof be by my Executors put to Interest
 Constantly & the Interest arising Therefrom to be Disposed of for the
 use of the poor of the aforesaid parish of St. Bartholomew, the other
 Two Thirds to be Equally Divided between Joshua Sanders & Jacob
 Donom, my Land only Excepted to the Said Joshua Sanders & his heirs
 for Ever and I Will Joshua Sanders be the whole and Executor During
 His Natural Life & Lastly I do constitute & appoint Joshua Sanders
 of the parish aforesaid and Jacob Donom to be my Executors to this my
 Last Will Requiring them to see the Same Executed and performed, In
 Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal, this Tenth
 Day of December 1797. Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence

 to me That John Colleton now of this Province Esq^r who hath been
 Deired that he may take into his Care, the Charge and Management
 of the Said Infant Child and her Estate, and may be appointed
 her

Now Guardian. Therefore, for the better Securing of her Estate,
 And for the more careful Maintenance and Education of the said
 Infant Child out of the Confidence I Repose in the Wisdom and
 Integrity of him the said John Colleton Do hereby commit the
 Tutelage, Guardianship & Education of the said Infant Child to
 The said John Colleton According to Their Desire; hereby
 Charging him that he do maintain her in Meat, Drink,
 Washing, Lodging, Clothing, & such Good Education as May be
 Fitting, according to the Circumstance & Interest of the said
 Infant Child During her Minority; and that the said John
 Colleton do Inquire into, & Take Care & Charge of her Estate, both
 Real & personal, & Do all other things as a Guardian by Law
 may Do and a True & faithful Account thereof & what Part
 of the said Anne Colleton shall come to his hands to render,
 when she shall be here required by such Guardian, as shall be
 Chosen by the said Infant Child when she shall attain to the
 Age of one & Twenty Years.

 arising thereby (after my Just Debts are paid) to be Equally
 divided between my said Children Edward, Mary, Hillensson
 and Catharine. —

And Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and
 appoint my loving Friends Edward Croft and Childermas Croft
 and my said Son Edward Wigg Executors of this my Last
