of my Executors herein after named I Will &
Ordain that all my just Debts and funeral
Charges be Paid & Discharged with all Convenience
Speed after my Decease I Give & bequeath
unto the Reverend Mr Hugh Stewart Minister
of the Gospel in Charlestown aforesaid One
hundred Pounds Current money of this Province
to be raised & Paid out of my Estate real &
Personal I Give all the rest & Residue of my
Personal Estate as well as all my real Estate
Lands & Tenements & whatsoever & whatsoever
I Give Devise & bequeath unto my dear
beloved Wife Ann Livingstone to her heirs
Executors Administrators and Assigns for
ever & I hereby Nominate Constitute & appoint
my said Wife Ann & sole Executrix
of this my Last Will & Testament In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand &
