my said well beloved Wife Catherine Dunn Sole Executor of
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking disannulling
and making void all other Wills and Testaments by me
before made ratifying acknowledging publishing and
declaring these presents to stand and be for and as only my
last Will and Testament In Witness whereof to this my
last Will and Testament I have set my hand and seal
the seventh Day of March Anno Domini One thousand seven
hundred and thirty Eight

 Loving Wife Mary Shrewsbury to hold unto my said wife
 during a life time for ever And I do nominate and appoint my
 Wife Mary Shrewsbury to be whole and sole Executrix of this
 Will and I do revoke all others or former Wills by me at any time
 before made declaring this to be my only last Will & Testament
 Witness whereof I Tho^s and Edward Shrewsbury have hereunto
 set my hand & Seal this 18 day of May Anno Domini 1781/82 And in
 the fifth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the second
 King of Great Britain &c.
