 Lick and weak of Body but of sound and disposing Mind and
 Memory thanks be to God for the same and Considering the uncertainty
 of this life do make and declare these presents to be and Contain my
 Last Will and Testament First and principally recommending my
 Soul into the hands of my Great Creator Trusting in the Merit of my
 blessed Saviour for pardon of my sins, and my body to the Earth to be
 decently Buried at the discretion of my Executors herein after named
 and for the disposition of such worldly Estate which it hath pleased
 to Bless me with I Give devise and bequeath the same in manner
 following that is to say - In Primis I Will and Order that all
 Just debts and Funeral Expenses be paid and discharged in convenient
 time after my Decease - Item I do hereby as far as in me lieth

My Executor my wife Elizabeth and myself the said Elizabeth
 do hereby certify that on the Twelfth day of February 1799
 One thousand seven hundred and Twenty nine to Elizabeth my
 (my dear wife) and Capt. Philip Deas for purchasing the State
 and personal of my said Dear wife in her own personal liberty
 retaining it to be my will and desire that my said wife, her heirs and
 assigns shall have hold and enjoy all and singular the State real and
 Personal and the increase thereof which either in her own right or under
 the Last Will and Testament of her late husband John Kieridge she was at
 the time of Executing the said Deeds possessed of situated in or adjacent
 unto which I hereby declare to be the true Intent and meaning of the
 said Deeds of Agreement - Item Whereas by my Executors
 in power of Attorney by me made and executed on or about the third
 day of September One thousand seven hundred and Twenty eight unto
 John Moore and Citizens and Merchants of London said Citizens
 and Merchants the said John Moore to sell alien and convey unto any
 Person or Persons whatsoever all my Estate Land Tenements and
 Hereditaments in the parish of Bertham Buckingham and
 also held in the County of Berks and likewise in pursuance of the said
 Power the said John Moore hath contracted with William Waterman
 of Bertham in the said County of Berks for the absolute sale of
 my said Estate Lands and Tenements in the said County of Berks
 and likewise in pursuance of the said Power the said John Moore hath
 contracted with William Waterman of Bertham in the said County
 of Berks &c. for the absolute sale of my said Estate Lands and Tenements
 in the said County of Berks and which were conveyed by me unto
 the said John Moore the purchase money for the same agreed to be
 paid by the said William Waterman being One thousand and thirty
 pounds sterling I do hereby authorize empower and appoint the
 said John Moore to make and perfect this deed with the said
 Waterman and for that purpose to make seal & cause any Statute deeds
 deeds of Conveyance necessary to be done for the selling and conveying
 the said Land Tenements &c. and to cause the same to be conveyed unto the said William
 Waterman his heirs and assigns in fee And I do hereby order and direct

that the said John Moore shall have receive and take to be
out of the said sum of One thousand and thirty pounds
all sum and sums of money which are due and owing unto
from and the Testator unto all fees and Charges attending the
Sale of the Premises to the said John Moore remitting into
hands of my Executors herein after named the over plus the
Item, I give devise and bequeath unto my dearly beloved wife
Elizabeth her Executors Administrators and assigns all my
Household goods plate rings Jewells and wearing apparels
I shall dye possessed of or constituted unto

Item all the rest and residue of my Estate real and personal
(not herein before particularly devised directed or ordered
otherwise) I do hereby devise authorize and empower my
Executors herein after named or the Acting Executor of them or
the Survivor of them to Sell alien and convey in fee simple
or otherwise on or before the first of January next to any
or persons whatsoever and out of the moneys arising thereby
order and direct that all my Debts be first discharged and paid
and the residue and remainder of the moneys arising by the
of all my Estate real and Personal as aforesaid I give devise
and bequeath to and among my said dear wife Elizabeth
and my dear Children Elizabeth Vicaridge and Ann Vicaridge
equally to be Divided share and share alike and I do hereby
order and Direct that the parts or shares of the said moneys
hereby Given to my said Children be put out at Interest to
said Executors on good Securitys for the Use and Benefit
said Children And Lastly, I do hereby Nominate and appoint
my said dear wife Elizabeth and John George Austin Executors
and Administrators of this my last will and Testament hereby
and making null and void all former and other wills by me
heretofore made and declaring these presents wrote on three
pages of post paper to be and contain my last will and Testament

A Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the
seal of my office in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and thirty seven John Vicaridge
Parish of St. Andrew's parished and declared by the within named
John Vicaridge the Testator to be and contain his last will and
Testament in presence of us who in his presence and at his
request have signed our names as Witnesses hereto

Before James Michie Esq. Deputy Secretary of his Majesty
Province of South Carolina by virtue of a Decree of the
Hon. the Thomas Broughton Esq. Lieutenant Governor and Commander
in Chief of the said Province which was done in the City
of August 1737 Personally came and appeared John Vicaridge and
two of the Witnesses to the above Instrument who being
sworn on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God declared they were
present and saw the above and within named John Vicaridge the
Testator sign and publish and declare the said Instrument of writing
and contain his last will and Testament and that he was at
that time of sound & disposing mind memory & understanding
of the contents knowledge and they severally subscribed their
names as Witnesses together with John Vicaridge in presence of the said
Testator & at his request (Edmondie sworn the Oath)
