I John Wauchope of Charles Town Merchant being weak in Body and of perfect Memory and Understanding Do Make Publish & Ordain this my Last Will and Testament First and principally I Commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God Hoping for Salvation through the Merits Death & passion of my Lord & Only Saviour Jesus Christ and my Body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried in decent Manner Item I Give & bequeath unto my Beloved Father James Wauchope of Camerons in the Kingdom of Scotland after the payment and satisfaction of my just & Lawful Debts all my Estate both real & personal of what Nature soever & in case of his Death unto my beloved Brother's & Sisters in Life to be equally and proportionably divided amongst them and I Do appoint my Dear Friend and Cousin John Scum of Charles Town a Merchant Executor of this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and Other Wills by me heretofore made I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Twenty fourth day of September Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Nine
