 for which I thank God & considering y^e mortality of my Day do think
 necessary to settle my busyness which I do in y^e following manner Viz^t
 I order that all my Dut. debts be truly and honestly paid with the
 Charges. Item I give to my friend Wm Chapman y^e is att this instant
 with one one hundred acres of Land y^e Joyce. Mr James Serousens to
 be divided by a north and South Line and as much money as will pay
 a bond of Mr Chapman to Mr Henry Dillon y^e I provided y^e said
 Redcoat would pay so I give y^e above y^e premises to y^e above y^e said
 and his heirs for ever. Item I give y^e track of Land y^e former due in
 two nephews Samuel Elliott and Joseph Elliott to be Equally
 between them by a north and South Line. Item I give to y^e Society
 Christians of Mr Henry Reynolds is now minister of y^e Free Will
 y^e two Brothers Wm Elliott & Barnard Elliott and my only sister
 Annamariae Tarr are now members of: I lay to this Society or to the
 persons whom they shall appoint to receive it, I give the sum
 of Five thousand pounds and three hundred thirty three pence
 six shillings & eight pence & my share of y^e Land on y^e said
 town neck for ever. Item I give to my friend Joseph Elliott
 twenty eight feet of my Land fronting Church street and
 fifty feet back adjoining Matthews & one hundred pounds one boy
 one horse called Jemee Grey and all y^e money y^e he owes me to his
 heirs and assigns forever. Item I give to my friend Joseph Elliott
 he comes to y^e age of twenty one years two hundred acres of Land
 adjoining y^e said Thomas Elliott Land y^e he now lives on y^e town
 likewise is that all y^e Rest of my Estate both Real and Personal
 sold and my Debts and Legacies all paid as soon as they convenient

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 can be and what money remains afterward shall all of it be
 Equally divided between my two Brothers Wm & Barnard Elliott
 and my sister Annamariae Tarr & them there heirs and assigns
 for ever, I appoint my Brother Wm Elliott my Brother Thos
 Tarr and my Cousin Thomas Elliott to be y^e Executors of this
 my last will and testament & as such I confirm it with my
 hand and seal this Eleventh day of February one thousand seven hundred
 and thirty nine

 the said eight in Mr Elliott's Legacy was subscribed before the
 signing and sealing of the will of Wm Turner Sarah Turner Catherine Smith
 signed and sealed in y^e presence of us Wm Turner Sarah Turner Catherine Smith
 Before the Hon^{ble} Wm Bull Esq^r Lieutenant Governor & Secretary
 of the Province of South Carolina personally came & appeared Wm
 Turner Sarah Turner Catherine Smith three of the Witnesses to the
 within Improvement of Writing who being duly sworn declared that
 they were present and saw Joseph Elliott the Testator sign Seal
 Publish and declare the same to be and contain his last will and
 Testament & that at the time of his Executing thereof he was of
 Sound & disposing mind memory & understanding to the best of the
 Deponents Knowledge & belief and further that they there
 upon set their hands as Witnesses therein in the presence of the said
 Testator
