 I the said William Miller of the County and in the Province of South Carolina
 being of full Age and of sound Mind and Memory thanks be given
 therefore Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body knowing that
 I am appointed for all men Once to die do make & Ordain this my last Will
 & Testament, That is to say, First of all and Principally I give and
 bequeath my Soul into the Hands of God that Good Lord my Body
 I commend to the Earth to be Buried in Christian Decent Manner at
 the direction of my Executors Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection
 I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God And as
 I have not worldly Estate wherewith I have provided for my
 dear Wife I give and bequeath to her the sum of one hundred and
 thirty seven Pounds that is to say for her use I give & bequeath to her
 the said sum of one hundred and thirty seven Pounds and one third part of the said sum
 for her life time, And one half of my Personal Estate with
 the said sum of one hundred and thirty seven Pounds and one third part of the said sum
 to continue my Widow, Provided None shall take the said sum
 upon the place while she enjoys it and shall not have the said sum
 having any other person therein by any Contract or otherwise while
 she lives. And in case she shall be married or any other
 shall be fit to marry again, My Will is that she shall have the said
 sum of one hundred and thirty seven Pounds and one third part of the said sum
 and one half of my Personal Estate with the said sum of one hundred and
 thirty seven Pounds and one third part of the said sum of what she shall
 have and one third part of the said sum of what she shall have
