Water Courses Woods underwoods Timber & Timber trees
Hereditaments & Appurtenances therunto belonging
Part of my said Plantation with one Moiety or half
Part of all my Plantation Tools to be by him freely
Possessed and Enjoy'd by him his Heirs & Assigns for ever

with all the Rents Issues & Profits

of the said Part of a Town Lot and Premises to be Equally
Divided between them Share and Share alike I Desire and
Empower my Executors and Executrixes hereafter nomina-
to Sell and Dispose of that Part of the said Town Lot Wth
for ready Money and the Money be put out to Interest untill
my said Daughters shall come to the Age of Sixteen Years
or the Day of Marriage which shall first happen, and
then the Principal and Interest arising therefrom is equally
to be Divided between them Share and Share alike I also
give my said Daughters each of them a Negro Girl to be
by them freely Possessed and Enjoy'd by them their Heirs &
Assigns for ever.

And I will and Desire that my said Wife may have her

Term of her Natural Life.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my well beloved Daughters
Ann Wilson & Margaret Wilson part of a Town Lot in
Charlestown with Dwelling house and Buildings Tenements
and hereditaments therunto belonging, Situated in Ellists
Street known in the grand Model of the said Town by the
Number Eleven now in the Tenure and Occupation of

with all the Rents Issues & Profits
of the said Part of a Town Lot and Premises to be Equally
Divided between them Share and Share alike I Desire and
Empower my Executors and Executrices hereafter nomina^d
to Sell and Dispose of that Part of the said Town Lot w^{ill}
for ready Money and the Money be put out to Interest untill
my said Daughters shall come to the Age of Sixteen Years
or the Day of Marriage which shall first happen, and
then the Principal and Interest arising therefrom is equally
to be Divided between them Share and Share alike I also
give my said Daughters each of them a Negro Girl to be
by them freely Possessed and Enjoyed by them their Heirs &
Assigns for ever.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister in Law
Elizabeth Tidling a good Suit of Mourning.

I Item I give and bequeath unto John Fiddling One young Negro man to be bought for him and paid for by my Ex^{rs} and Executives out of my Estate to be by him freely possessed and enjoyed by him his heirs and assigns for ever.

I Item I will and desire that my Plantation at Wadsworth may be sold by my Executors and Executives To Enable them to pay their Debts & Legacies and do hereby Empower and give full Authority to them for the Selling and disposing thereof as they shall think proper.

I Item I give and bequeath unto the Child that my wife is now big with in case it be born alive a Legacy of one Thousand Pounds of good and Lawful Money of South Carolina Five Hundred Pounds being Part thereof to be levied and paid by my Executors and Executives out of the Apartment and Portion allotted for my Son John and the other Five hundred Pounds to be also levied and paid out of the Apartment and Portion allotted for my son Moses Wilson To be by such Child freely possessed and enjoyed by his or her heirs and assigns for ever. And in case it be a Boy I do also give and bequeath unto him an Equal Part & Share of the Remainder of my Negroes Stock Goods Chattels Estate both real and personal not yet disposed of to be by him freely possessed and enjoyed by him his heirs and assigns for ever. And in case it Proves to be a Female I also give to such Daughter One Negro Girl to be by her freely possessed and enjoyed by her her heirs and assigns for ever and I desire she may be brought up and maintained at my Plantation.

I Item I give and bequeath unto my Wellbeloved Wife Margaret Wilson and her sons all the rest Residue and

Remainder of my Negroes Stock Goods Chattels & Estate both real and personal not yet disposed to be equally divided between them share and share alike To be by them freely possessed and enjoyed by them their heirs & assigns for ever Lastly I do hereby Nominate and Appoint Isaac Holmes and Captain William Saunders Executors and my Wellbeloved Wife Margaret Wilson and Elizabeth Fiddling Executives of this my last Will and Testament hereby Revoking disannulling and making void all former and other Wills by me heretofore made Ratifying Confirming and allowing this to stand and be for and as my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day & Year first above Written and notwithstanding I have by the above Will &c divided my Goose Creek Plantation into two Parts and given the same to be settled by my two Sons John Wilson & Moses Wilson Yet if it shall be thought hereafter more for the Benefit and Advantage of my said Sons to have the same Plantation sold I do by this Present Codicil Give Devise and Empower my said Executors & Executives to Sell and Dispose of the said Plantation Negroes and Stock for Money and let the same be Equally Divided as Intended by the above Will In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day and Year first above Written.
