In the Name of God Amen I Paul Marion of Goose Creek in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina Planter being Sick and weak of Body but of a Sound and Disposing mind and Memory Do make and Ordain this to be my Last Will and Testament first and Principally I Commend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that Gave it, and my Body I Commit to the Earth to be Decently buried according to the Discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned, and as to such worldly Goods as the Divine Providence has bestowed on me I Give Devise and Dispose of them in Manner and form as hereafter followeth that is to say first.

I will that all my first Debts be paid off and Discharged.

Item I will that my whole Estate both Reall and Personall be sold within one year after my Decease and that one third part of the money be paid unto my Well beloved Wife Elizabeth and the two other thirds be put out at Interest for the use

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of my two Sons, Paul and Peter to be Divided between
them when they Come to the Age of Twenty one
Years Share and Share alike and in Case one of
them Should Die I will and it is my Desire that
the other inherit the Share of the Deceased
Item I do hereby Nominate Constitute and appoint my
Trusty and well Beloved Wife Elizabeth Marion
and My loving brother Peter Marion to be the
Executors of this my Last will and Testament
Revoking and Disannulling all former Wills by
me at any time heretofore made and Declaring
this Alone to be and Contain my Last Will and
in Witness whereof I have to this my Last will and
Testament Set my hand and Seal the twenty
Seventh Day of October in the Year of
our Lord God one Thousand Seven hundred
and thirty Seven.
