And further I do hereby Constitute, make and
appoint my well Beloved Brother Daniel Ravenel sole
Executor and Administrator of this my last will and
Testament,

and I will and do earnestly charge mine Executor
that the before mentioned Legacies be duly paid -
within six Months after my Decease and I do hereby
utterly disallow, revoke and disannul all and every
other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Requests and
Gifts, by me in any ways before this time named
