and bequeath the like sum of fifty Pounds current money of the Province
to my Daughter Penelope Edgley to her own separate use and
free from any intermeddling of her husband Item I have devised &
bequeath after my Debts and funeral Charges are paid all the
rest and residue of my Estate real & personal to my daughter
Elizabeth Stollard her heirs &c. &c. & assigns forever to have &
their only proper use and be hope AND lastly I do hereby nominate
& appoint Robert Smith of Charlestown afores^d Esq^r & my S^c of
Daughter Eliz^a Stollard Exec^{rs} of this my last will &c.

I Thomas Elliott of Berkeley County in the province of S Carolina being very Sick & weak of Body but of Perfect mind and memory & Considering the mortality of my body do think it proper to settle my Business and make this my Last will and Testament which is as follows.

Imprimis I Order that all my debts shall be Honestly Discharged and paid.

Item I Give Devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Elliott one negroe Man named Toby and his Wife Lucia one Girl named Rachel and three thousand Pounds Current money to be paid unto her a thousand pounds a year untill the whole be paid by my Eors and all this money and three negroes above named I Give to her her heirs and assigns forever in Lieu of her Dower.

Item I Give devise and bequeath unto my loving Son Thomas Elliott three negroes by their names Harry Doll and nancy to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I Give devise and bequeath unto my loving Son Benj Elliott three negroes by their names Quarts, Peg & Buck to him his heirs & assigns for ever.

Item I Give devise and bequeath unto my loving Son Samuel Elliott three negroes by their names Samson Eley and Abraham to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto the reverend Robert Ingram Minister three hundred Pounds Current money to be paid within one year after my decease to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto the Reverend Th^{os} Sumners Minister fifty Pounds Current money to be paid within one year after my decease to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my loving Brother Joseph Elliott one tract of land containing five hundred and eighty acres in S^t Bartholomew Parish on the west side of Pon Pon River lately granted to me by Th^{os} ^{marsh} Broughton late Governour, and one other tract of land containing five hundred & twenty Acres in S^t Pauls Parish granted to me by William Bull Present Governour and these two above said Tracts of Land I Give to my Brother Joseph Elliott his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I Give devise and bequeath unto my loving Brother Barnard Elliott three thousand three hundred and thirty three pounds Six Shillings and Eight Pence Current money of the province aforesaid which was left me by my fathers will charging him to make that good use of it for which he knows it was given me I Give to him his heirs his heirs and assigns forever.
