Derogatory in the same or promise to the contrary
and this to be taken only for my Last will and
Testament and none other. Imprimis I bequeath
my soul to Almighty God that gave it and my
body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried
in such decent manner as to my Ex^{ors} shall be
thought meet and Convenient and as touching
such Temporal Estate of Goods Land Chattels
and debts as the Lord hath been pleased to bestow
on me I do give Order and bequeath & dispose of
Same to my beloved Wife Margaret Belton and
lastly I make Ordain Constitute and appoint my
said Wife Margaret Belton Sole Ex^{tr} of this my
said Last will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal at Charles
Town

of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace
of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King &c.
