Imprimis I bequeath my soul to Almighty God that gave it and my body to the Earth from whence it came to be buried in such decent manner as to my Extrae shall be thought meet and convenient and as touching such Temporal Estate of Goods Land Chattels and debts as the Lord hath been pleased to bestow upon me I do give Order and bequeath dispossession of same to my beloved Wife Margaret Bellon and lastly I make Ordain Constitute and appoint my said Wife Margaret Bellon sole Executrix of this my said last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Charles
