Therefore for the better securing her Estate and for the more careful maintenance and Education of the said Child out of the Confidence I repose in the Wisdom and Integrity of the said Andrew Rembert Do hereby Commit the Tutelage Guardianship and Education of the said Infant Child unto the said Andrew Rembert according to his desire hereby Charging him that he do maintain her in meat drink Washing Lodging Clothing and such good Education as may be fitting according to the Circumstances & Interest of the said Infant Child during her minority And that the said Andrew Rembert do Enquire into and take care and Charge of her Estate both the real and personal and do all other things as a Guardian by law may do, and a true and faithful account thereof and what Estate of the said Esther Querry shall come to his hands to render when he shall be thereto required by such Guardian as shall be Chosen

I do hereby will and bequeath unto all and every testamentary and lawful will and Will heretofore made by me either by word or writing and first being penitent and sorry for my sins past most humbly Desiring forgiveness for the same I give and Commit my soul unto Almighty God my Saviour and Redeemer in Whome and by the merits of Jesus Christ I Trust and Believe to be Saved and to have forgiveness of all my sins and that my soul with my Body at the General day. Resurrection shall rise again with Joy and through the merits of Christ death and passion I hope to inherit the Kingdom of Heaven prepared for the Elect and Chosen and my Body to be buried in such place where it shall please my Executors hereafter named to appoint and now for the settling of my temporal Estate and such Goods Chattles as it hath pleased God for above my Dearest to bestow upon me I do Order give and dispose of the same in manner and form following (that is to say) first I will that all my Debts be lawfully paid within convenient time after my Death by my Executors hereafter named. I give for the good love and affection I do bear unto my Beloved Wife and for the good will and I bear unto John Burnett and John Querry and for Divers other Reasons mo I do hereby specially moving I do nominate and appoint my Wife John Burnett John Querry Executors of this my Last Will and Testament, Item

It is my Will that all the Land I have on the North side
 of Santa River and also all the Land that is on the North
 side of Santa River shall be sold after my Death by my
 Executors, Them, Whom into my three sons Elsie, Whithis
 and John all the same I have on the South side of Santa River
 which is about Nine hundred Acres in three tracts to be equally
 Divided between my three sons in above named, First I
 give and bequeath unto Margaret my Deceased Wife One third
 of all the Remains of my Estate that is to say Negroes harn
 Cattle and all what I possess except lands and the other
 two thirds of what I possess except lands to be Equally Divided
 among all my Children for Witnes Whom I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal the day and Year first above
