 by my Executors hereafter named within convenient
 time after my Decease.

Item I Give and bequeath to my Dear Father Joseph
 Parminter two Negro Fellows by name Robin
 Andrew as long as he lives and after that I Bequeath
 them to my Loving Wife Mary & her heirs forever
Item I Give and bequeath to my Loving brother Benj
 Parminter a Tract of Land containing two Hund.
 and

And sixteen Acres at Port Royal and
 also a Black Horse at the Pallachoculus
 branded PP. and to his heirs for ever.

Item I Give and bequeath all the Rest of my worldly
 Estate both Real & Personal to my Loving Wife Mary
 and her heirs & assigns forever.

And Last by I do appoint, ordain & constitute
 my Dear Father Joseph Parminter Tho^s Parminter
 Senr and W^m Jackson Executors of this my Last
 Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I do here
 by Set my hand & Seal the day & Year above
 Mentioned.
