give and dispose thereof as followeth.

Impress. Will that all my just Debts and funeral expences be first paid.

Item. I give Devise and bequeath unto my loving Wife Martha the use of
my Plantation whereon I now live consisting of One Hundred and
thirty Acres of land and also of an negro Woman named Venus with
a young Child and her increase, my said Wife to have peaceable use of
the said plantation negro Woman and Child with her increase -
During her natural life with all the appurtenances thereunto,
belonging all which above said legacies and bequeaths I give Devise
and bequeath unto my said loving Wife Martha in full and for her
Power.

DOWN and third or share of my Real and personall which
she can or may Claim by any ways means or pretence whatsoever,
out of my said real or personall Estate.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my youngest son James Combe the said
plantation whereon I now live to be enjoyed after his Mothers Decease
or hath attained to the age of majority, To have & to hold the said
Plantation (after my Wife Decease) to my said son James his heirs and
assigns for ever.

Item. I give and hereby authorize and empower my Executor and Executor,
hereafter named and the survivor of them to sell and dispose of the
five hundred Acres of land that were run out for me on Winyaw
Whereof the plot is in the Office to be annexed to a grant for the most
money that can be gotten for it which money with the rest of my =
Personall Estate I live Devise and bequeath to all my Children John
Paul Francis Phillip Dagmaris Mary Magdalen Susannah and
Martha to be equally Divided and shared amongst them.

Item. I Ordaine Establish and appoint my loving Wife Martha
Executor and my loving son John Executor of this my Last Will
and Testament hereby Revoking and annulling all other
Wills and Testament heretofore by me made and this to be and
Remain for my Last Will and Testament, In Witness =
Whereof I have set my hand and seal this 22^d day of february
1794/5.

Before the hon. ble Thomas Broughton.
Esq. Lieutenant Governor Commander in
Chief and Ordinary of this his Majesty's =
Province of South Carolina.

Personally appeared before me this 10 day of March,
1736. J. John James Sibot and Anthony Bonneau two of the
Subscribing Witnesses to this Will who being duly sworn Declared
they were present and saw the testator Phillip Combe sign seal and
pronounce to be his last Will and testament and that Guillaume
Yallantine the other Witness subscribed his name at the same time
with them as a Witness to this Will and also that the said Testator,
Phillip Combe was at that time of sound disposing mind and
understanding, to their belief.

Jesus Christ, to have full and free pardon of all my sins and to inherit
Everlasting life, and my body I commit to the Earth to be decently
buried at the discretion of my Executor hereafter named, and as touch-
ing the disposition of all such temporall Estate as it hath pleased
God to bless me with I give and dispose thereof as followeth.

tem. I Will that my debts and funerall Charges shall be paid & Discharged.
tem. my Will is that all my Estate both personal and Real shall be sold
by my Executor hereafter named, my Negro boy here Excepted.
12 tem. that my dear and Well beloved Wife Joh. Traator shall have one 3^d.
Part of the Value of my personal Estate for Ever, and one third
of the income of my Real Estate during her Natural life and all the
Rest and residue of my Real Estate I give to my son Charles Traator
and if he doth not live to Come of age to Receive it that then Mary
Willson, and Febe Gurneall his sisters in law shall have that part
that dth belong to him and I do hereby make Constitute and appoint
John Abet. for Traator and John England to be Executors of this my
Last.
