Georges Parish & Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina being sick & weak in Body but of sound Mind and Memory Do Make this my last Will and Testament in manner & form following First and Principally I Commit my soul to Almighty God that Gave it Hoping & Trusting that through the Mercy and Intercession of my Beloved Saviour Jesus Christ I shall receive full & free pardon and remission of all my sins And my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such Decent and Christian manner as to my Executors hereafter named shall seem meet and convenient And as Touching such Worldly Estate as I have pleased the Lord in Mercy to send me, my Wife and mine the same be Bestowed in manner & form following Impressed My Will and desire is That all my Just Debts be duly paid by my Executors near as I may. Item My Will is That after my said Just debts be paid & estate be divided in manner and form following (That is to say) Two parts thereof into my Son Edmund Borne, And the other third part unto my Daughter Hannah Hunt, to them and their Heirs in full and Default of Issue from either of my said Children then I wish their Portion to go to the Survivor of them. Item I will & Bequeath unto my Son Edmund, my Little Gun, Over & above the part above mentioned. And my wearing apparel. Item My Will is That my Body be buried in a plain Coffin, & four pair of Good Gloves, be Given to the Poor of the Parish thereof. Lastly I hereby nominate constitute & appoint, my said Son Edmund Borne
