Winn four hundred acres of Land at Sculls Swamp
in Colleton County Being Part of two tracts as above
Like wise an Equall Share of two thirds of my
Personal Estate with his Brothers & Sisters John Winn

Item I Give & Bequeath to my well beloved Son Joseph
Winn new Dwelling House & one hundred Acres of

Personal Estate with her Brothers & Sisters (Wives) John
Robert & Joseph Winn Martha Winn Sarah Winn
Katherine Winn & Rebekah Winn.

Item It is my will that my wellbeloved Daughters
Martha Winn Sarah Winn Katherine Winn &
Rebekah Winn have Each of them an Equall Share
of two thirds of my Personal Estate with their
Brothers John Robert & Joseph Winn and their
Sister Ann Nelson.

Item It is my will that the remainder of the third my Wife shall or may leave at her Decease be Equally Divided among all my children (Wife) John Robert and Joseph Winn Ann Nelson Martha Winn Sarah Winn Katherine Winn and Rebecca Winn.

Item It is my will likewise that if either of my Sons Die before he arrive to the Age of Twenty one years his Land be divided between his two Surviving Brethren.

Lastly I constitute & Appoint my well beloved Sarah Winn Executrix my well Beloved Son John Winn my well Beloved Son in Law William Nelson my well Beloved Friend Thomas Sumner Executors of this my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereto set my hand and seal this Twentieth Day of August 1738.
