Marriage which shall first happen all the Rest and
Refined my Estate of what Nature and kind soever and
hereafter I give Devise and Bequeath unto my said
wife Mary and Jas Cromore and appoint my said
wife Maryfull and sole Executrix of this my last Will
and Testament Revoking all former Wills Jn Witnes
